

CONSTRUCTION PROJECT MANAGEMENT:

Amongst all the projects, the most notable would be a \$5.5 Mil home in Toorak. The home consisted of a basement car park for 5 cars, as well as storage areas, wine cellar, movie theatre, office, amenities plus a lift to the upper floors. Other main points of the house included full parquetry throughout ground floor, indoor swimming pool, double kitchen, gym, marbled floor entry foyer, 5 bedrooms with separate ensuites. Basement construction utilised bored piles with shotcrete walls, then steel framed and plastered to a flawless level 5 finish. One of the main features of the house was a mirrored finish vinyl ceiling over the indoor swimming pool.
